

Alumni Association Awards and Bursaries

In order to receive the award or bursary, the student must be enrolled, full time, in a post-secondary institution or apprenticeship program that has been approved by the Ministry of Education. Awards may be deferred for up to **five** years.

Alumni Centennial Awards, Career Preparation Awards and Alumni Subject Awards require the recipient to have made a documented contribution to the school and/or community or to have been involved in volunteer work. While this is important, it may be waived in exceptional circumstances, such as where a student has had to work to support themselves.

- For a student who has obtained good academic standing, and who
 - Has been involved in school and community service, and
 - Has participated in Victoria High School athletics

Dorothy Evans Music Bursary

- awarded to a student who plays a musical instrument, has been a member of a school or district music program and shows promise, or the potential to become a professional musician.
