Lucy was born into a pioneer Victoria family (Jeeves/Woodruff) and graduated from Victoria High School (1938) and St Ann's Academy in the secretarial program. She worked for the provincial government after graduation and subsequently met her beloved Charles, a returning Air Force veteran in August 1944 (first date picture above). They were married on the 29th of August 1945 in St John The Divine Church in Victoria. This began a 41-year adventure in travel, the raising of a family, and building a life with the man of her dreams. Upon retirement from the RCAF, Charles and Lucy moved to their long anticipated and lovingly built home in East Sooke. After the premature parting of her dearest husband in 1986 Lucy moved into Victoria where she actively shared rich times with her many friends and enjoyed the company of the growing generations of her family. In her last years, Lucy lived at Aberdeen Hospital in Victoria and finally at Menno Hospital in Abbotsford.
