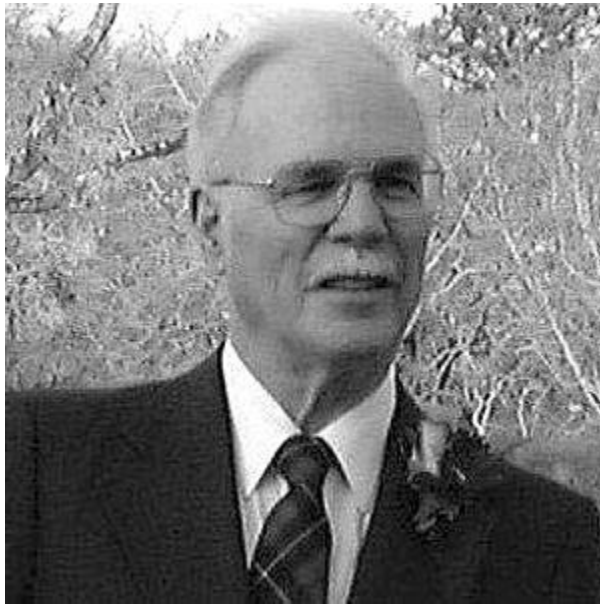


## Wallace Mark Bailey ('46)
