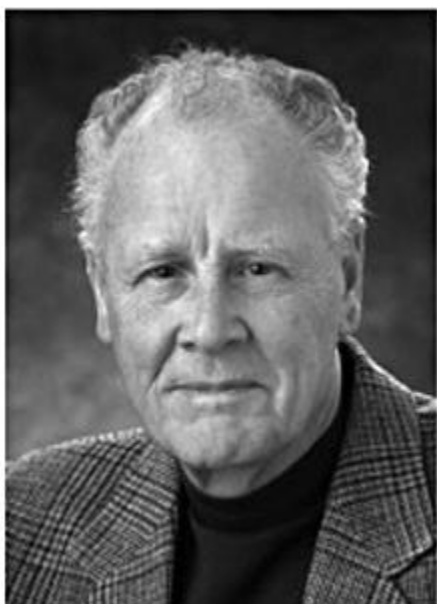


Pierre François d'Estrube – VHS 1941
