

## Vote for Vic High!

You've probably noticed the tall sign on the school grounds near Fernwood and Vining, where notices are posted for coming events. The school would like to replace the old manual sign with a modern electronic one – so that information can be instantly updated from a keyboard inside.

With the support of the Vining Street Party Society and the Greater Victoria School District, Vic High has applied to the City of Victoria for \$28,555 for this project, from a pool of \$50,000 in a new program called Participatory Budgeting. And our project is one of 8 finalists chosen from 28 applications!

Here's how you can help. **Go online and vote for the Vic High sign.** Click on <http://www.victoria.ca/EN/main/city/current-initiatives/participatory-budgeting.html> and follow the instructions.

Any resident in the CRD can vote – you don't have to live within the City boundaries. Only one vote is allowed per computer or device. (We wonder if that means you can vote from both your laptop and your phone . . .)

You may vote for up to 3 of the finalists, but you're also allowed to vote for just 1. (We asked.) There's a short survey too, but it takes less than 3 minutes to complete.

What a great chance to show the collective strength of Vic High's Alumni! This can only help us as we continue to seek funding from senior governments for the Stadium Revitalization vision.
