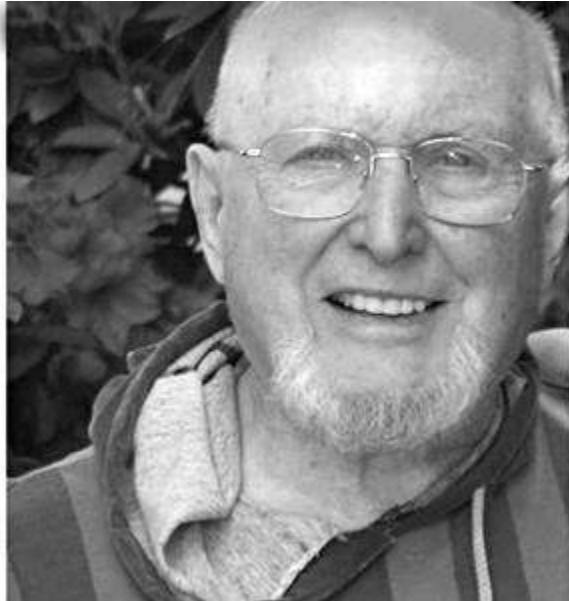


Donald Barrington "Barry" Camp – Vic High Teacher
