He was born in Edmonton, Alberta to William Morgan Evans and Ada Edith Millard. He was predeceased by his wife Anne in 2010, and his brother Bob in 1991. Dad was also a very committed lifetime member of the Union Club of BC in Victoria and was a very loyal "nooner" who enjoyed his snooker Fridays. As a young man he was involved as an equestrian rider on the Tyson property located on Cedar Hill Cross Road, which was later developed into townhomes which he and Anne lived in for several years. As an adult he continued with his love of sports becoming very active playing squash early on, and then playing tennis and golf into his 80's. He and Anne travelled the world for many years, passing on that passion for travel to many of his children and grandchildren.
