



BARNETT, Howard Byron BA, MA, MMus, Phd. May 10, 1920 - January 10, 2015, age 94. Born in Victoria on May 10, 1920, Howard died peacefully on January 10, 2015. Predeceased by his wife, Shelagh and daughter, Debora; he is survived by his son, Terry (Susan), grandsons Marcus (Christina) and Michael (Karen) and great-grandchildren Ethan, Maria, Skyla and Tavin. Howard attended Victoria High School and Victoria Normal School and taught school in Ucluelet and Hedley. During [WWII](#) he served in the Canadian Navy, commanding a motor torpedo boat in the English Channel and was Executive Officer on a frigate doing convoy duty in the North Atlantic.
