As for the private side of her life, she leaves to mourn, her brothers Charles (Hazel) and Edward (Wilma - deceased), her loving children Brent (Carrol), Ron (Cindy) and Sue (Bob Vincent). She was a loving Nana to numerous grandchildren, a Great Nana and Auntie. She had an intense love of family, and she was one of the first to hold her grandchildren. Now God is holding her and He has sent the Holy Spirit to comfort us. Florence lived a long and

committed life. Life was not wasted on her. She extracted the best of it and never looked back. She is an example to all of us to live a full and happy life. Mom passed away May 14, 2022.
