We regretfully announce the peaceful passing of Stan on July 5th, 2023 with his wife Della by his side. He was born December 13, 1933 in Victoria, BC to Wilfred Stewart and Alberta Oke. Stan grew up in Victoria, attending Vic High where he excelled at basketball and earned his nickname "Bones" for his tall lanky frame. During the mid 1950's, Stan played on the Senior "A" Softball Gorge Hotel Team that won a then record 6 consecutive BC titles from 1954-1959 for which the team was inducted into the Victoria Sports Hall of Fame in 2012.

When Stan's baseball playing days were done, he found his next sporting passion, Golf and became a member of the Gorge Vale Golf Course for 45 years.

Stan worked for 30 years at the DND dockyard in the transport division.

In his early adult years, he enjoyed fishing and coaching his son in little league baseball. Later on, he took up gardening and was known around his neighbourhood as having a lawn so pristine it resembled a putting green.

Stan leaves his wife of 63 years, Della and his daughter Shawn (Larry) and son Darren, grandchildren Brent (Leah) and Alanna (Kevin) and 4 Great-grandchildren Nya, Rhys, Carter and Makena and a number of nieces and nephews.
