



**KEMP, Audrey Frances (née Hayley) (1962)**  
**October 31, 1945 - August 25, 2023**

On Friday, August 25, 2023, after a wonderful day with family in London, Ontario, Audrey Kemp of Clinton passed away at the age of 77. She is predeceased by her parents Alonzo and Dorothea Hayley of Victoria, BC.

Our Mom loved her family dearly and leaves behind her children Christine (Carl) of London, Rob (Linda) of Toronto, and Alonna (Ian) of London. She was a proud member of Beta Sigma Phi, and gratefully received her 60-year Diamond Circle pin during a lively party in her honour just days before her death.

As an active member of Wesley-Willis and then Clinton United Church for 50 years, she enjoyed participating in UCW meetings, bazaars, dinners, and penny races. She taught Sunday School for many years, but her greatest joy was singing in the church choir. Our mom was a dedicated volunteer for the Alzheimer Society of Huron-Perth. She deeply valued the opportunity to support the important services they provide. In 2022 she was humbled to receive the Gandon Award in recognition of her contributions.

Always interested in the world at large, Mom was an avid reader, CBC Radio listener, and enthusiastic traveller who visited Ireland, Curacao, and Scandinavia in recent years.
