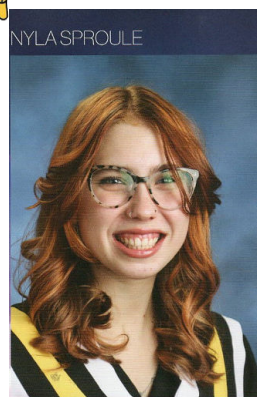




Reg Reid Leader Scholarship
